#### **CHOICES: Drug & Alcohol Counselling for Youth**

We are inviting applications for the position of supervisor with CHOICES: Drug & Alcohol Counselling for Youth. The position is available immediately.

Established in 1989, CHOICES provides assessment, treatment planning, counselling and referral for youth with substance abuse problems and those affected by the substance abuse of a significant other. The program is funded by the South West Local Health Integration Network and Ontario Ministry of Health and Long Term Care. It is one of nine community-based mental health and addiction programs operated by HopeGreyBruce Mental Health and Addictions Services.

CHOICES is based in Owen Sound and extends regular outreach to high schools and communities across Grey and Bruce counties. Program staff work closely with other health and social services which serve youth and their families.

The position entails both management and clinical responsibilities. Reporting to the Director of Addiction Services, the Supervisor oversees the day-to-day operation of CHOICES and provides senior practitioner level clinical services to program clients. Management duties include staff supervision, coordination of intake, monitoring and evaluating service delivery, establishing and maintaining effective liaison with program stakeholders, participation in service planning and coordination, community development and public relations. The position requires regular travel throughout a large rural catchment area. Work hours are somewhat variable and some evening work is required.

#### **POSITION REQUIREMENTS:**

- Masters Degree in Applied Health Sciences with concentration in clinical studies.
- Must obtain and maintain Registration in a regulated health profession
- Minimum of 5 years community-based clinical experience with youth, including youth who have substance abuse problems
- Clinical experience in delivery of addiction treatment services
- Supervisory and/or management experience preferred
- Demonstrated clinical skills in working with youth and their families
- Strong communication, interpersonal and leadership skills
- Strong oral and written English language skills
- Strong public presentation skills
- Experience in rural service delivery would be an asset
- Proficiency in the use of personal computers for word processing, email and data entry
- A valid driver's licence and use of a personal vehicle are required for this position
